Milltown Green Team promotes safe walking, biking to school

MILLTOWN — The borough Environmental Commission's Green Team wants to make sure children in town are able to walk or ride their bicycles to school safely.

The Green Team announced Monday it is working on a "Safe Routes to School" project, funded by Sustainable Jersey and in cooperation with Milltown Public Schools.

The purpose of the project is to examine the safety of children walking or bicycling to schools in the borough. The Green Team will study how many children walk or ride their bike to and from school currently, how safe the various routes are, and how they might be made safer. In collaboration with the schools, the team will encourage these modes of travel by holding walk-to-school and bicycle-to-school events, as well as a public meeting to discuss the process.
