## Guest column: Local programs to teach about sustainability

Maple Shade has joined 354 other New Jersey communities as a registered member of Sustainable Jersey.

“Sustainability” is more than just recycling; it involves personal and civic activities which aim to reduce waste, foster efficiency, and leave resources available for future generations. Becoming a sustainable community means that Maple Shade and its residents will take purposeful steps to create a better quality of life by incorporating thoughtful practices into everyday living.

Activities that qualify as sustainable range from buying goods from local businesses to historic preservation to reducing waste in our schools. A comprehensive sustainability program links certification with strong state and private financial incentives, and a fully-resourced program of technical support and training.

Maple Shade hopes to create a Green Team to implement these goals and earn certification as a Sustainable Community. A presentation on the process by a representative of Sustainable Cherry Hill, a leader in the movement, is tentatively scheduled for the council meeting on Thursday, March 2, at 7 p.m., at Town Hall.


