Jersey City demographic overview








The Office Of Innovation used a variety of communication techniques to develop initiatives to support small businesses



Communication case study: small business initiatives





Digital kiosks provide interactive communication devices in key high traffic areas







Why should we care?

- What is the role of the government?
- Municipalities must address the needs of the residents
- The way we communicate and receive information has changed drastically
- Every municipality has information that needs to be shared
- Meeting Info, Events, Important Updates, Celebrations of Success, Changes in Leadership, etc.

Benefit of Citizen Engagement


Why use a digital platform?

- Better community relations with local organizations, nonprofits and businesses






What kinds of budgets?




