

Education for Sustainability has multiple, positive effects on student achievement, school culture, community vitality, and ecological integrity.























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



Sustainability in the School of Education





TCNJ is a state college with 6600 undergrads and 1000 grad students. Approximately 1/4 of students are in education related programs.







What We Knew

- Few undergraduate teacher prep programs directly geared toward Environmental Sustainability Education
 - Environmental Science
 - Environmental Studies
 - Environmental Policy
- Efforts at the state and national levels to support environmental education
- TCNJ has an "Environmental Studies" minor, but no education majors participate


In NJ

Sustainable Jersey is a certification program for municipalities in New Jersey that want to go green, save money and take steps to sustain their quality of life over the long term. Launched in 2009, it provides tools, training and financial incentives to support and reward communities as they pursue sustainability programs.





- Voluntary certification program for schools and to include curricular and non-curricular actions to teach for sustainability
- Includes guidance, support, and financial incentives for participating schools
- This creates a need for teachers prepared to teach for sustainability



- NJ School Boards is working with the Cloud Institute
- Jaimie Cloud provided PD for our ad hoc advisory committee

Option in Sustainability

TCNJ education majors can choose dedicated sections of certain required courses to prepare for a "specialty" in Educating for Sustainability.

 Field experiences and student-teaching are conducted with 'green teachers" at "green

schools."

Development of the Minor

- Pre-service and practicing teachers urged us to ground our minor in teaching and learning
- 3 "core" courses
- 2 enrichment courses
 - 1 in the natural or physical sciences
 - 1 in the social sciences, arts, or humanities
- Culminating project

Environmental Sustainability in Education: An Introduction

- Offered for the first time in Spring 2015
- Provides a broad scope of what environmental sustainability looks like in schools
- Included field trips, guest lectures, online and face-to-face discussions

NEWJERSEY

Environmental Science for Educators

- Aligned tightly with the NGSS
- Offered for the first time Summer 2014
 - Initial data suggests students are developing proenvironmental teaching orientations
 - Blended format: online activities, face-to-face labs and lectures, field trips



Sustainability & Society

- Blended format (online and face-to-face)
- Addresses environmental sustainability in arts, humanities, and social sciences instruction

Program Launch: October 2014



- As of April 16, 2015
 - 81 School Districts Registered
 - 208 Individual Schools Registered
 - 70 Schools and Districts Applied for Certification

- Program Enrollment
- Outreach and Training
 - Webinars on Getting Started, Creating your Green Team,
- Grants program- 3 grants cycles already announced
 - PSEG \$100,000
 - NJ Department of Health \$120,000 (due June 27)
