Bicycle Plan Step 1: Town-Wide Bike & Pedestrian Survey

- Why do people walk & ride in Town?
- > Where do people want to walk or bike (Origin/Destination)
- > What stops people from walking or riding bicycle?
- > Hazard locations for walking and biking?
- Priority areas for bicycle parking.
- > Priority roads for on-street bicycle facilities

Bicycle Plan Step 3: Draft Bicycle Plan

- ➤ Review other municipal Bicycle Plans Cut & Paste
- Collect data on street widths, volumes, speeds, accidents, etc
- Use Steering Committee to draft Vision Statement, Goals& Objectives
- Document Existing Conditions
- ➤ Identify priority Bicycle Network based on Destinations
- Conduct NJDOT Bicycle Compatibility Assessment
- Determine possible Bicycle Facilities for priority roads
- Obtain public input
- Develop Implementation Plan









Morristown Bicycle Plan: Concept 1




Streets Plan: Primary Activity Street




Streets Plan: Secondary Activity Street




Streets Plan: Township Thoroughfare
