Sustainable Jersey is pleased to announce that the PSEG Foundation is contributing \$200,000 to support a Small Grants Program cycle for municipalities and \$100,000 to support a Small Grants Program cycle for schools.

Green Infrastructure Demonstration Showcase

A key feature of New Jersey Future's Mainstreaming Green Infrastructure program is the advancement of demonstration projects that illustrate the powerful benefits of green stormwater infrastructure in public- and private-sector development or redevelopment. New Jersey Future will select two high-profile green infrastructure demonstration projects - one public-sector and one private-sector - located in one of the William Penn Foundation's Delaware River Initiative Areas: the Highlands of northwest New Jersey or the Kirkwood Cohansey Aquifer area of southern New Jersey. New Jersey Healthy Corner Store Initiative (HCSI)

The New Jersey Healthy Corner Store Initiative is offering mini-grants to support local healthy corner store initiatives throughout the state. Mini grants of up to \$1,500 per store (or up to \$5,000 per city) are available for the implementation of Healthy Corner Store strategies, such as mini-conversions, that will increase the availability and marketing of healthy foods. Eligible applicants include corner store owners, non-profit organizations, or other community-based partnerships working to increase the sale of healthy food in New Jersey corner stores.

It Pay\$ to Plug In

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and Board of Public Utilities have teamed up to launch a new "It Pays To Plug In" grant program. The first phase of the program will provide \$725,000 in reimbursement grants to offset some of the costs to purchase and install electric vehicle charging stations. The grants are a component of the state's "Drive Green New Jersey" initiative that also includes a website with information about the different types of electric vehicles available, how to charge them, affordability, and impact on air quality. The grants are offered on a first-come, first-serve basis of up to \$250 for each Level 1 charging station installed, and up to \$5,000 for each Level 2 charging station installed. Eligible applicants include public, private, for-profit, nonprofit, educational and governmental entities. Owners of parking facilities used by commuters or employees of other companies are also eligible. 
Renewable Electric Storage Program

The New Jersey Board of Public Utilities is offering this program which provides financial incentives for electric energy storage systems that are integrated with Class 1 renewable energy projects installed behind-the-meter at non-residential customer sites. This program will support the installation of renewable electric storage systems in government, commercial, institutional and industrial entities for the purpose of providing emergency back-up power for essential services, offsetting peak loads, and/or helping stabilize the electric distribution system through the provision of frequency regulation services. The open enrollment program offers an incentive of \$300 per kWh of energy capacity, and the maximum incentive per project is \$300,000 or 30% of the project's total cost, whichever is less. 
