Funding Available for Municipalities and Schools



Sustainable Jersey is pleased to announce that the PSEG Foundation is contributing \$200,000 to support a grants program cycle for municipalities and \$100,000 to support a grants program cycle for schools.

Home Energy Upgrades for You and Your Residents

New Jersey's <u>Home Performance with ENERGY STAR Program</u> (HPwES) offers generous rebates and low-interest loans to homeowners to upgrade their homes to more energy efficient and comfortable dwellings. HPwES, which is administered by the Board of Public Utilities and its <u>Clean Energy Program</u>, has upgraded the energy efficiency of over 30,000 homes in NJ since 2006. HPwES not only saves energy and money, it also addresses health and safety issues prior to making a home more energy efficient.

Funding Opportunities

Compressed Natural Gas Heavy Vehicle Grant Program

If your municipality has been looking to switch from traditional trucks and buses and other heavy duty vehicles to compressed natural gas (CNG) ones, now may be the right time. The New Jersey Board of Public Utilities' CNG heavy vehicle grant program helps fund the incremental cost of a CNG powered vehicle over a comparable diesel vehicle. Awards will be capped at \$20,000 per vehicle and \$40,000 per applicant and will be processed on a first-come-first-served basis until funding is exhausted. Volkswagen Settlement Project Proposals

New Jersey, as a potential beneficiary of the Trust established pursuant to the national Volkswagen settlement, intends to use its allocation from the mitigation trust to efficiently implement projects that reduce oxides of nitrogen (NOx) emissions in a cost effective and technically feasible manner. New Jersey has issued a solicitation for project proposals to ensure that a broad range of ideas are considered. Opportunities for public input will be provided in the coming months.
