Program Summary: Attached find Resolution. North Brunswick has created a Green Team which has been named Sustainable North Brunswick Advisory Committee. The Committee meets once a month and has applied for several grants including Sustainable Jersey Wal-Mart Grant, EECBG, and Greenhouse Gas Emission Reduction Grant. These grant projects include a Victory Garden,

Farmer's Market, Bike/Pedestrian Paths within the township, replacing the municipal building's antiquated boiler with a much more energy efficient model. The Committee is planning a booth at North Brunswick Annual Heritage Day and has invited representatives from PSE&G and New Jersey Clean Energy to educate our residents about using more energy efficient practices within their homes.
