Reporting Requirements

2019 PSEG \$2,000 Grants

Schools due May 30

Municipal due April 30

All \$2,000 grantees are required to complete a final report in order to close out their grant. The report should only be submitted once the project is complete. Sustainable Jersey staff will work with grantees on their final reports until they include the information and documentation required for approval.

Failure to submit the required documentation will result in a municipality being ineligible to apply for future Sustainable Jersey grants. The final fifty percent of the grant funding will be disbursed upon receipt and approval of the documentation listed above.

NOTE: You may save your work, log out and resume your in-progress report at any time. Drafts of the report will automatically save every 5 minutes, and a "save draft" button is available at the end of the report form. It is also encouraged that you save a copy of your completed report for your records.

- If your project is not complete, DO NOT submit the final report at this time
 - Request an <u>extension</u> (up to one year) for more time to complete the project
 - Request a <u>budget revision</u> to spend down any remaining grant funds (or ask to return them)
 - Request a <u>project modification</u> if you are unable to complete steps of the project originally proposed

 - Variations fromOriginal Proposal

If any, they must have been pre-approved by Sustainable Jersey unless they were not significant changes to the scope of work or budget. Significant changes in a project budget when more than 10% of the grant is reallocated for a different purchase. If you are unsure, please contact us.

 - Social media posts and other outreach campaign materials such as email, mailings, etc.
 - News articles

It's summer. You're a kid in the neighborhood, hanging out with your friends when suddenly a police car rolls up. An officer gets out and starts strolling toward you with something in his hands.

He's a holding a ball. But it's not just any ball, this one's brand new. It's a Spalding and it's got a really cool Winslow Township Police Department (NJ) logo on it.

Game on!

Winslow Township police officers just received hundreds of new basketballs and footballs that they're giving to children, but not just by rolling down their window and staying in the patrol car.

Nope. This is about getting out and hanging out with the kids in the communities they serve. "It's awesome," Chief George Smith tells me, "We're doing pick-up games. The officers actually get out of their cars, start up conversations and play some ball with the children. Then they give them the balls."

Just. Love. This.

The township got a grant from Sustainable New Jersey for \$2500. The thing is, the department serves 40,000 people in Winslow, Sicklerville, Berlin, Blue Anchor and parts of Hammonton and Waterford and balls are expensive. The money wasn't going to buy many balls. So, Chief Smith reached out to Spalding directly—told the folks what he was hoping to do. They loved the idea so much that they sold him 200

footballs and 250 basketballs at cost and sprung for the shipping

topped \$800).

And so now, don't be surprised to see a group of kids laughir a police officer, getting their game on and, maybe most impogetting along if you happen to be cruising through Chief Smir South Jersey.

What's In The Bag?

Depending on your take-out order, you should have gotten some more sustainable packaging along with a bright green reusable bag to keep. The brown Bio-Plus Earth containers are competitive in price, made in the U.S.A. from 100% recycled paper (minimum of 35% post-consumer content, 100% processed chlorine free). Bio-Plus and Southern Champion food trays can be recycled when cleaned of food. The Eco Products soup containers included in some orders are not recyclable, but are made with 29% post-consumer recycled content which helps save natural resources. Their lids are not recyclable but are made from PLA, a plant based plastic from 100% renewable resources rather than oil.



Why Change The Take-out Packaging?

We wanted to reduce plastic and Styrofoam consumption by putting more sustainable take-out options into the hands of local restaurants. No material is perfect, all will impact the environment in different ways, but some are better than others! We could all supply our own reusable containers for take-out but the next best solution is for restaurants to switch to more confriendly packaging.

VI. Project Expenditures

Please provide an itemized list of expenses paid for by the grant funds. For Example: Garden Plants: \$525.00, Tools (rakes and shovels): \$125.00, etc. Be sure to include a correct accounting of the grant expenditures to ensure that the grant closeout process is as efficient as possible. Funds may not be kept in reserve. The expenditures can be listed in the text box below OR provided via an uploaded file.

If there is funding leftover after the proposed project is complete, grantees then have two options: either closing the grant out as-is, which means they would have to return/relinquish any remaining funds, or requesting an opportunity to finish spending down the funds. The grant will remainin open during the time required to finish spending the funding and the final report sould not be submitted until after all of the desired funding as been spent. Any funding remaining that the recipient does not wish to spend will be returned/relinquished to Sustainable Jersey. Requests should be sent to grants@sustainablejersey.com. Leftover funding can be used toward any eligible expense for a project related to any of the Sustainable Jersey actions or that will support the green team.

The uploaded files must be in PDF format. Multiple documents can be combined into one file. If you upload the wrong pdf, you can overwrite the file by uploading the correct pdf.



Can then decide to close out as is or spend down the remaining grant funding on additional project materials or green team expenses. **MUST** be preapproved before remaining funding can be spent.





- Project Expenditures submissions...
 - Can be an itemized list for \$2,000 grants (financial documentation is not required)
 - Must include an itemized list and financial documentation for large (\$10,000 or \$20,000) grants
- Can submit ledgers (see right), receipts, paid purchase orders, etc.
