What is Sustainable Jersey?


- Certification program for municipalities and schools




Clean Energy Act of 2018

- Sets ambitious goals for GHG reduction reduce 80% by 2050
- Clarifies need to reduce annual energy and emissions from buildings: 2% for electricity and 0.75% for natural gas
- Shifts responsibility for residential and commercial efficiency programs to public utilities
- Municipal outreach greatly increases participation among residents in clean energy programs

PSE&G's Mission

PSE&G Clean Energy Future

- September 2020: New Jersey Board of Public Utilities approved PSE&G's Clean Energy Future energy efficiency program.
 - This cleared the way for PSE&G to commit \$1 billion toward energy efficiency over three years.
 - It is the largest commitment to energy efficiency in New Jersey history.
 - It includes 10 programs tailored to help all residential and commercial customers reduce their energy use with energy-efficient equipment, technologies, and strategies.

PSE&G is committing \$1 BILLION toward energy efficiency


Energy Tracking & Management

For 10 points

- Building portfolio
- Most recent <u>twelve-months</u> of energy use data for all buildings

For additional 10 points

- Benchmarking report for each building in the inventory
- Demonstrate <u>ongoing</u> Energy Tracking and Management system



Energy Efficiency for Facilities





5 points - Audit on at least one building

10 points - Local Government Energy Audit (LGEA)

15 points - Significant upgrade work

20 points - LGEA on all buildings PLUS significant upgrade work

30 points - Efficiency upgrades; 10%-19% decreased energy use

40 points - Efficiency upgrades; 20%-29% decreased energy use

50 points - Efficiency upgrades; at least 30% decreased energy use

Program Details – Funding

- Program Start-up Grant of \$2,500
- Outreach Campaign Grant of \$5,000
 - Supplemental grants will be available on a competitive basis to support Outreach Campaigns

A second Outreach Campaign Grant is available on a competitive basis to all communities, subject to the availability of funds, with priority given to high need communities (as determined by a community's MRI Rank, based on the NJ Division of Community Affairs Municipal Revitalization Index (MRI).

- Apply for PSE&G incentives or prepare LGEA application with SJ support

Application Process

- Submit online application
- Choose track
 - Technical Assistance
 - Residential Energy EfficiencyOutreach Campaign
 - Commercial Energy EfficiencyOutreach Campaign
- Municipal resolution required
- Applications due: March 2023
