We are pleased to announce that the Gardinier Environmental Fund is contributing \$150,000 to support a Sustainable Jersey Grants Program cycle for municipal governments and public school districts that is focused on supporting energy projects and programs. **The cycle will award grants in the amount of \$10,000; \$20,000; \$30,000; \$40,000; and \$50,000.**

The number of grants in each category will be based on the relative strength of application proposals received. We reserve the right to not give grants in any specific category. Please note that funding for grant proposals at the higher levels is more competitive.

Applicants may only submit ONE grant application. The application can be for any of the listed grant amounts.

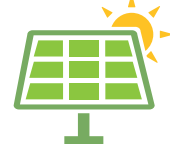
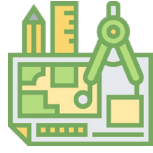

Eligible Projects

Existing Building Energy Efficiency ● Electrification ● Renewable Energy
Energy Reliability/Resiliency ● Transportation Efficiency and Electrification
New Construction/Significant Renovation ● Studies, Plans, and Engineering



Applicants interested in purchasing alternative fuel vehicles are only eligible to apply for class 4-8 medium and heavy-duty vehicles such as.

- Delivery/Freight Trucks
- School, Shuttle, and Transit Buses
- Garbage Trucks
- Snow Removal Vehicles

Ineligible Projects



Lighting ONLY Upgrade Projects

This includes street lighting, stadium lighting, parking lot lighting, and other exterior and interior lighting. Direct Install projects for the replacement of HVAC equipment, boilers, etc. that also include lighting upgrades will still be considered.



Electric Vehicle Charging Station Purchases

Applicants interested in installing EV charging station(s) should apply for NJDEP's "It Pay\$ to Plug In" program or NJBPU's Clean Fleets EV program. Information on these programs is available in Section M. of the Application Information Packet.



Light-Duty Electric Vehicle Purchases

Applicants interested in purchasing light-duty electric vehicles such as police, code enforcement, and utility vehicles should review other funding opportunities listed in the Sustainable Jersey Alternative Fuel Vehicle Procurement Guide available at bit.ly/AFVProcurementGuide and the NJDEP resources flyer available at bit.ly/EVResourcesFlyer. Funding is also available via the NJBPU's Clean Fleets EV program.
