Through the NJ Department of Environmental Protection Resilient NJ Program, Sustainable Jersey is providing technical assistance for municipalities to complete or update a Climate Change-Related Hazard Vulnerability Assessment (CCRHVA), which is required by the NJ Municipal Land Use Law to be included in the Land Use Plan Element of all municipal Master Plans. The technical assistance will apply the methodology outlined in the Guide to Local Climate Change Adaptation Planning.
