

Apply to be a New Jersey Healthy Town

The New Jersey Health Care Quality Institute's Mayors Wellness Campaign (MWC) developed the Healthy Town designation to distinguish communities in which mayors have made health and wellness a top priority. Each year, Healthy Town designations are awarded to recognize community health and wellness activities conducted the past calendar year. The deadline to apply to be recognized for 2020 health and wellness activities is **January 29 at 5pm**. Municipalities recognized by the MWC as a Healthy Town or a Healthy Town to Watch in the current or previous year can earn 25 points for Sustainable Jersey's <u>Building Healthier Communities action</u> by simply uploading a copy of their Application for New Jersey Healthy Town Designation and documentation of the award (i.e. certificate, notification letter, press release, etc.) to its Sustainable Jersey certification application.
